- The Village of Edenwold gave first reading to Bylaw 2022-01 A Bylaw for the Village of Edenwold to provide for entering into an agreement for the District Development Appeals Board. The agreement is attached to the bylaw as Appendix "A" and includes the municipalities of Town of Balgonie and Town of Pilot Butte.
- Last July, 2021, the Village of Edenwold successfully completed a grant intake for the SGI Provincial Traffic Safety Fund; the results were released December 30th, 2021. The Village of Edenwold was awarded \$13,050.00 funding to be put towards two major speed displays. Our application was one of 99 in that round of applicants. The new speed display sign/boards will be effective later this year. The initiative is to enhance road safety.
- The Rink Affordability grant through SPRA was again successful for this season. The amount for the Rink Board was \$2,500.00.
- A reminder that Q1 water/sewer billing will increase by \$10/mo. Starting this month, as was advertised during the 2021 year.
- The 2021 Audit is set for Feb. 2nd, and 3rd, 2022, with Dudley and Company LLP auditors.
- Next compost rotation date for the green household bin is February 7th, 2022; at 7 a.m. curbside.
- **A new fee** will be added to Community Hall Rental Fees effective January 1st, 2022. All function rental fees remain as is, however, there will now be an additional charge of **\$100** on all rentals where the kitchen is in use. Birthday parties are the exception with an increase of **\$25** for kitchen usage.
