The next regular scheduled Council meeting will be held on Wednesday, **August 17th, 2022**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m. [Wednesday meeting due to summer vacations].

**Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries.** There has been an increase in dog incidents this year, ultimately resulting in Bylaw enforcement. **A reminder that all dog owners' must be responsible for their pet(s), at all times.**

- 2022 Property Tax Notices are due in full December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. A 5% discount is available on or before July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 (Municipal portion); and a 3% discount is available on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (Municipal portion).
- Council acknowledged receipt of the final copy of the 2021 Financial Statement and approved the synopsis to be mailed out to the ratepayers' accordingly.
- Public notice is hereby given that the Council for the Village of Edenwold will not be giving any readings to Bylaw 2022-02 Extension of Time – Financial Statement – as the 2021 Financial Statement received by the Ministry of Government Relations by June 24th, 2022. The deadline under Sections 186(1) and 189(3) of *The Municipalities Act* reached.
- Casual Administrative Assistant position (advertisement is on the bulletin board at 128 Chamberlain Street; and was previously mailed out) with the Village of Edenwold has been extended to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at 3:30 p.m. or upon filling the position whichever comes first. - The White Butte Regional Emergency Measures Organization has operated since 2017. Recently, the RM of Lajord accepted membership into the EMO. The Village of Edenwold will pursue a new Bylaw #2022-03, and repeal the former Bylaw #03-2017 in due course.
- As per Government of Saskatchewan's *Building Code Regulations*; new law on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, to have residential carbon monoxide alarm and smoke alarm systems
