### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next regular scheduled Council meeting will be held on Monday, **July 11th, 2022**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

**NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold; please refer to**

**Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries.** There has been an increase in dog incidents this year, ultimately resulting in Bylaw enforcement. **A reminder that all dog owners' must be responsible for their pet(s), at all times.**

- 2022 Property Tax Notices are due in full December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. A 5% discount is available on or before July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 (Municipal portion); and a 3% discount is available on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (Municipal portion).
- **Education Property Tax mill rates were set by the Province of Saskatchewan in early May, 2022; as follows:**
  - Agriculture 1.42 mills**
  - Residential 4.54 mills**
  - Comm/Ind 6.86 mills**
  - Resource 9.88 mills**
- **The Village of Edenwold council passed 2022 Final Budget reflecting \$434 surplus; the uniform mill rate was set at 5.255 mills for Village of Edenwold 2022 levy.**
- Budget calculations included extensive monitoring of fuel and carbon tax adjustments in several service provider accounts. There was provision for another estimated 1.5 miles of road gravel, that has delivered to several streets in the Village. Some culvert/road work along with some building maintenance items were also on budget. Grant funding also will see the placement of 3 I-Safe digital speed signs.
- Public notice is hereby given that the Council for the Village of Edenwold will pass Bylaw 2022-02 Extension of Time – Financial Statement at the July regular council meeting; should the document not be received at the Ministry of Government Relations on or before June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The municipality can extend time to September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, if required.
- Council approved the 2021 Financial Statement in draft version. There was extensive work required following the annual Audit to finalize the major infrastructure



work (potable water pipeline agreement) that evolved during the year of 2021. Ratepayers' will be mailed a synopsis once the final statement is received; it will reflect the increase to asset portfolio for the Village of Edenwold.

- Management's Responsibility letter was signed by council for the 2021 Audit financial statement approval.
- Casual Administrative Assistant position (advertisement is on the bulletin board at 128 Chamberlain Street; and was previously mailed out) with the Village of Edenwold has been extended to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at 3:30 p.m. or upon filling the position whichever comes first. For more information please contact the Village office at 306-771-4121.
- **Please be reminded to burn only clean, cut - firewood pieces, if using back yard fire pits. Keep in mind low or no wind; mindful of your neighbouring properties. Bylaw 04-2016.**
- **As per Government of Saskatchewan's *Building Code Regulations*; it is considered law on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, to have residential carbon monoxide alarm and smoke alarm systems installed and working in all residences'.
