COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next regular scheduled Council meeting has been set for Monday, **November 14th, 2022**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold; please refer to

Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries. There has been an increase in dog incidents this year, ultimately resulting in Bylaw enforcement. A reminder that all dog owners' must be responsible for their pet(s), at all times.

- **2022 Property Tax Notices** are due in full December 31st, 2022.
- Quarter 3 water/sewer billings have been mailed. **As a reminder; in accordance with the current Bylaw 2021-03, a January 1, 2023 increase to the monthly water rate of \$5.00/mo. was pre-approved by Saskatchewan Municipal Board when the Bylaw was enacted. Monthly water rate will alter from \$80.00 to \$85.00, sewer remains unchanged at \$25.00/mo. Quarterly bills will alter from \$315.00 to \$330.00/QTR.**
- **Bylaw 2022-03 was given second and third reading at the meeting.** A Bylaw to provide for establishing an agreement to Entering into a Regional Emergency Management Organization with The RM of Edenwold No. 158, The Town of Balgonie, The Town of Pilot Butte, The Town of White City and the RM of Lajord #128. (The former bylaw is repealed.)
- Council for the Village of Edenwold will consider first reading to **Bylaw 2022-04**, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the Town of Balgonie; at the regular scheduled council meeting to be held November 14th, 2022.
- Council for the Village of Edenwold will consider first reading to **Bylaw 2022-05**, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the Town of Pilot Butte; at the regular scheduled council meeting to be held November 14th, 2022.
