The next regular scheduled Council meeting has been set for **Monday, January 9th, 2023**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

**Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries. There has been an increase in dog incidents this year, ultimately resulting in Bylaw enforcement. A reminder that all dog owners' must be responsible for their pet(s), at all times.**

- **2022 Property Tax Notices** are due in full December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. A 15% penalty is levied January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, on accounts in arrears.
- **Village Office Holiday Hours; December 28<sup>th</sup>, OPEN/January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023, OPEN. December 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2023, Closed.**
- Quarter 3 water/sewer billings have been mailed. **As a reminder; in accordance with the current Bylaw 2021-03, a January 1, 2023 increase to the monthly water rate of \$5.00/mo. was pre-approved by Saskatchewan Municipal Board when the Bylaw was enacted. Monthly water rate will alter from \$80.00 to \$85.00, sewer remains unchanged at \$25.00/mo. Quarterly bills will alter from \$315.00 to \$330.00/QTR.**
- Q4 Water Meter reading cards have been mailed, please return the card upon receipt (days to read meter indicated) drop off at the Village office or email the reading to [villageofedenwold@sasktel.net](mailto:villageofedenwold@sasktel.net).
- **The real Christmas Tree curb side pick up is Tuesday, January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023. (by: Loraas Disposal).**
- Council for the Village of Edenwold made a unanimous motion to give all three readings to **Bylaw 2022-06**, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the RM of Edenwold #158; at the regular scheduled council meeting held December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

- Council motioned to engage Dudley and Company from Regina, Saskatchewan, for the 2022 Municipal Audit; which is set for February 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>, 2023; in office.
- Council of the Village of Edenwold confirmed by motion that the municipality meets the all eligibility requirements to receive the Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant from the Ministry of Government Relations. This grant will be received in June, 2023.
- Public Notice is hereby given that any property owner or renter that is 120 days in unpaid arrears at yearend; the arrears shall transfer from the Utility accounts to the Tax Roll accounts. Registered letters where previously sent in accordance with ***The Municipalities Act***/subclause 369 (1) (b) (ii).
- As per Government of Saskatchewan's *Building Code Regulations*; new law on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, to have residential carbon monoxide alarm and smoke alarm systems installed and working in all residences'.
