- The Village of Edenwold gave second and third readings to Bylaw 2022-01 A Bylaw for the Village of Edenwold to provide for entering into an agreement for the District Development Appeals Board. The agreement forms part of the Bylaw as Appendix "A" and includes the municipalities of Town of Balgonie and Town of Pilot Butte.

- Next compost rotation date for the green household bin is March 7th, 2022; at 7 a.m. curbside.
- **A new fee** will be added to Community Hall Rental Fees effective January 1st, 2022. All function rental fees remain as is, however, there will now be an additional charge of **\$100** on all rentals where the kitchen is in use. Birthday parties are the exception with an increase of **\$25** for kitchen usage.
