COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next regular scheduled Council meeting has been set for **Monday, December 12th, 2022**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold; please refer to

Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries. There has been an increase in dog incidents this year, ultimately resulting in Bylaw enforcement. A reminder that all dog owners' must be responsible for their pet(s), at all times.

- **2022 Property Tax Notices** are due in full December 31st, 2022. A 15% penalty is levied January 1st, 2023, on accounts in arrears.
- Quarter 3 water/sewer billings have been mailed. **As a reminder; in accordance with the current Bylaw 2021-03, a January 1, 2023 increase to the monthly water rate of \$5.00/mo. was pre-approved by Saskatchewan Municipal Board when the Bylaw was enacted. Monthly water rate will alter from \$80.00 to \$85.00, sewer remains unchanged at \$25.00/mo. Quarterly bills will alter from \$315.00 to \$330.00/QTR.**
- Council for the Village of Edenwold made a unanimous motion to give all three readings to **Bylaw 2022-04**, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the Town of Balgonie; at the regular scheduled council meeting held November 14th, 2022.
- Council for the Village of Edenwold made a unanimous motion to give all three readings to **Bylaw 2022-05**, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the Town of Pilot Butte; at the regular scheduled council meeting held November 14th, 2022.
- Council for the Village of Edenwold gives public notice that Bylaw 2022-06, to provide for mutual aid fire protection by agreement with the RM of Edenwold #158, may be given all three readings at the December regular scheduled council meeting.



- Council for the Village of Edenwold entered in to a new 5 year renewal of the Fire Suppression Service Agreement with the RM of Edenwold #158.
- Under ***The Municipalities Act***/subclause 142 (3) (a); (b) Annual Public Disclosure Statements were reviewed, signed, and dated noting any change or not to the information each council member had filed.
- Council for the Village of Edenwold supports by letter the Town of Pilot Butte grant intake submission for Water Treatment Plant Improvements.
- Public Notice is hereby given that any property owner or renter that is 120 days in unpaid arrears at yearend; the arrears shall transfer from the Utility accounts to the Tax Roll accounts. Notice will be issued by registered mail as per ***The Municipalities Act***/subclause 369 (1) (b) (ii).
- Council finalized major increases to the 2022-23 Sumassure renewal for village wide insurance coverage on buildings, contents, vehicle fleet, and equipment.
- As per Government of Saskatchewan's *Building Code Regulations*; new law on July 1st, 2022, to have residential carbon monoxide alarm and smoke alarm systems installed and working in all residences'. Please see www.saskatchewan.ca/smoke-co-alarms for more information.
- **A note for residents' to keep a watchful eye out for stop sign and speed infractions throughout the Village of Edenwold (*you may record a licence plate if you witness unlawful activity, and call it in to White Butte RCMP at 306-781-5050, accordingly*).**
