- **CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL GREENALL HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES IN THE CLASS OF 2023. To our local graduates we are proud of you and extend the very best for your future endeavours!**
- The 2023 Budget for the Village of Edenwold was approved by Council with a surplus of \$12967.00, and that sees the uniform mill rate remain unchanged at 5.255 uniform mill rate, Base Tax \$850 unchanged and the Land Only Minimum Tax \$200 unchanged; as per Bylaw 2021-02 Taxation Bylaw. The 2023 Education Property Tax (EPT) mill rates are; Agr 1.42; Residential 4.54; Com/Ind 6.86; Resource 9.88.
- Fire advisories are in effect within the Province already this year. The Village of Edenwold **Bylaw 04-2016**, is a source of information for every resident, please review the following excerpt from the bylaw:
  - A. Open air fires**
  - 1) No person shall start an open air fire within the Village of Edenwold unless that person has obtained a permit authorizing such a fire from the Village of Edenwold, with notification to the Village of Edenwold Volunteer Fire Department, as per Schedule A.
  - 2) The permit shall be in a form approved by the Village of Edenwold.
  - 3) Notwithstanding sentence 1), a permit shall not be required for an open air fire where:
    - a) The open air fire is in a fireplace, grill, or barbeque; or,
    - b) A recreational fire pit or cheminea other than those mentioned in clause a) and the following measures are taken to limit the spread of fire:
      - i) The fire is contained in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of concrete, clay, brick, or sheet metal;
      - ii) There is sufficient clear space between the fire, combustibles, and adjacent buildings (not closer in location than three (3) metres from any property line, building or other combustible structure and may not be closer than six (6) meters from any neighbouring or abutting building)
      - iii) Chimineas shall not be used on balconies, wooden decks or any combustible surface.
      - iv) The fuel used for the open fire is charcoal, cut wood pieces to fit within the pit, or manufactured fire logs.
  - 4) No person shall burn the following materials in an open fire, regardless of whether or not the person has obtained a permit:
    - a) Waste including rubbish, slimes, tailings, garbage, garden refuse or leaves;
    - b) Any material classified by the Village of Edenwold as a hazardous material or dangerous good;
    - c) Any material that generates black smoke or offensive odour when burned including, but not limited to, insulation from electrical wiring, rubber tires, asphalt shingles, hydrocarbons, plastics, and lumber treated with wood preservatives.
