COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next regular scheduled Council meeting for Tuesday, **October 10th, 2023, in lieu of Thanksgiving Monday**; is at the Edenwold Senior's Centre, 211 Chamberlain Street, Edenwold SK, at 7:00 p.m. Location change due to previous community hall booking.

NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold, walk with a leash at all times; please refer to www.villageofedenwold/community/bylaws/AnimalControlBylaw

There has been an increase in continuous dog barking coming from certain residences' in the Village of Edenwold. If you are a dog owner; **please take note**; The Animal Control Bylaw specifically states that you must maintain control over your pet and be a responsible pet owner. Neighbouring residents' have to listen to that noise which should be kept to a 15 minute time span in any given hour; and controlled accordingly. Contact the Village Office to register your pet annually. Bylaw Enforcement will also monitor when on duty.

- **3rd Quarter water meter reading cards** will be mailed to property owners' this week.
- **Edenwold Recreation Board** funding is available if your group/club is planning activity (sport/culture/rec) for 2023-24. The follow-up reports are due by the end of March 2024. Please submit your request to the attention of the Rec. Board c/o Village Office, 128 Chamberlain Street, Edenwold SK S0G 1K0, and/or drop off the request at the Village office, or email the request to villageofedenwold@sasktel.net
- **Property Taxes** due in full December 31st, 2023. September has a 3% discount running until September 30th, 2023, on the municipal portion of the tax bill. Available payment options are; E Transfer to villageofedenwold@sasktel.net Cheque, cash, debit/credit within the office. A 2.5% fee is charge if using the credit card.
- A Water Load Out point is being constructed at the Water Treatment Plant **WTP**, primarily for emergency use (the project will operate independent of the village distribution system, is on a separate electrical service, and can act as a system flush point if needed). The project funded through Canada Community-Building Fund; did receive approval August 23rd, 2023, from the Ministry of Government Relations (SK). Village Gas Tax funding will be utilized for the project with the majority of construction completed this month.
