The next Council meeting is on Monday, **December 9th, 2024**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m. is set by the Administrator for newly elected officials following the 2024 Municipal General Election. *The Municipalities Act* Section 121.

- **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Public notice has been given by Council for the Village of Edenwold to hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, December 3rd, 2024, at 7:30 p.m. in the Edenwold Community Hall; to consider recommendations made by the Edenwold Rink Board regarding the Edenwold Memorial Rink. Public Notification has been mailed locally, posted to social media and in a local newspaper.

- **PUBLIC AWARENESS – ATV's/Snowmobiles.** In accordance with the Village of Edenwold Traffic Bylaw 03-2013, it states that all terrain vehicles and snowmobiles only use the public streets as a method of quickest possible route when leaving or entering the Village. While driving, signage and the posted speed limit must be respected. Safety is a priority as many children, and parents come and go to school and daycare, community hall/church every day. [Recreational vehicles being driven for entertainment purposes – including quads, dirt bikes and/or mini bikes – any stunting, racing, joy riding in town is **not** allowed. The RCMP enforce **The Traffic Safety Act**, and it is recommended that people call these complaints in to the **White Butte Detachment 306-781-5050**.

- **2024 Property Tax** bills have been sent out in the mail, and are due in full December 31st, 2024. A 15% penalty is levied January 1st, on unpaid tax accounts. **Payment methods, debit/credit (in-office) 2.5% credit card use fee applicable; e-transfer to villageofedenwold@sasktel.net, Conexus Credit Union customers can access on-line banking (Telpay), cheques or cash. Please make payments payable to Village of Edenwold.**
- **Utility 120 day unpaid arrears at yearend, 2024, be moved to the tax roll and letters be sent 30 days prior to moving to the roll; by Registered Mail as per *The Municipalities Act*, Section 369, Clause (1) (b), Subclause (ii).** Local customers in arrears; may received the Registered Mail - only – due to current mail disruption nationwide.



- **The Canada Community-Building Fund- CCBF (formerly Gas Tax fund), has approved the Village of Edenwold - newly submitted Municipal Funding Agreement - over ten years to March 31st, 2034.** The first installment funding has been received and the Village of Edenwold is currently planning a 2025 project intake under road category infrastructure. Under the previous CCBF Agreement, the Village of Edenwold successfully completed an approved \$41,000.00 back up power project at the Water Treatment Plant. The newly installed generator has been in use on a few occasions, and is performing 100%.
- SK Lotteries Community Grant for 2024-2025 has been approved and received. If your group, club, committee has programming, costs, that may qualify, please contact the Village Office 306-771-4121, villageofedenwold@sasktel.net - for more details, or submit a letter request to Edenwold Recreation Board, PO Box 130 Edenwold SK S0G 1K0. The Board administers the grant money annually.
- **Compost** rotation is Friday, **December 13th, 2024** - once a month winter pick-up until April, 2025. New calendars will be forthcoming for 2025 household containers.
