COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **January 13th, 2024**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

Newly Elected officials, signed their Oath of Office and Public Disclosure Statements at the onset of the
meeting, being the first meeting following the Municipal General Election of Nov. 13, 2024.

SNOW CLEARING

Residents' pushing snow with bobcats are reminded to be respectful and mindful where they push the piles within the Village; as two major snow events and freezing rain have recently occurred making for an increase in street clearing village-wide.

- Council passed a preliminary budget based on 2024 figures until budget deliberations are underway in 2025.
- **2024 Property Tax** bills have been sent out in the mail, and are due in full December 31st, 2024. **A 15% penalty** is levied January 1st, on unpaid tax accounts.

- METER READS Q4 On December 22nd, 2024, residents' can start to email or call in their meter reads, a notice reminder will be posted on social media. The meter read cards will not be mailed due to the on-going postal strike.
- The Village has met compliance requirements for the annual Revenue Sharing program through the Ministry of Government Relations for 2025.
- Council set Deputy Mayor position as Councillor Paul Boehme.
- Council has engaged Dudley & Co. Audit firm for the 2024 Village of Edenwold annual Audit scheduled for March 12, 13, 2025; in office.



- The Village has entered another Infrastructure Investment Plan under Canada Community-Building Fund- CCBF (formerly Gas Tax fund), new funding agreement. The IIP is for repair to two more frost boil areas, one on Eden Street and one on 1st Avenue, along with an allotment of road gravel for several side streets and about 75 % of 2nd Avenue that was not done in 2024.
- Council made motion for Emergency Planning EOC (Emergency Operations Centre) as the Community
 Hall at 204 Brewer Street, and the Reception Centre for EOC as the Seniors' Centre at 211 Chamberlain
 Street.
- SK Lotteries Community Grant for 2024-2025 has been approved and received. If your group, club, committee has programming, costs, that may qualify, please contact the Village Office 306-771-4121, villageofedenwold@sasktel.net for more details, or submit a letter request to Edenwold Recreation Board, PO Box 130 Edenwold SK SOG 1KO. The Board administers the grant money annually.
- <u>Compost</u> rotation is once a month winter pick-up until April, 2025 for winter. New calendars for all
 household containers pick up dates are available in the foyer of the Village office building.
