PROPERTY ASSESSMENT Revaluation 2025

Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) next revaluation (every 4 years) is in 2025. Assessment notices will be issued to all property owners' with the Assessment Roll advertised open for sixty (60) days. The Assessment Roll will be open February 26th, 2025 to April 28th, 2025. Details included with the mail-out.

The Agency used a 2023 base date for the current revaluation. You can view property assessments online at www.sama.sk.ca.

Council, during the budget/mill rate deliberations, will adjust the uniform mill rate accordingly to minimize the impact of the overall levy. Changes in assessed value from on-going or completed building permits, or demolitions, will still result in individual increases or decreases in assessed value. Changes in relative valuations between different properties could also have an individual impact on assessments.
