- **PROPERTY ASSESSMENT Revaluation 2025**

Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) next revaluation (every 4 years) is in 2025. Assessment notices have been issued to all property owners' with the Assessment Roll advertised open for sixty (60) days in Grasslands News (Quad Town Forum) and the Saskatchewan Gazette. The Assessment Roll will be open February 26th, 2025 to April 28th, 2025.

The Agency used a 2023 base date for the current revaluation. You can view property assessments online at www.sama.sk.ca.

During the budget/mill rate deliberations, Council will adjust the uniform mill rate accordingly to minimize the impact of the overall levy. Changes in assessed value from on-going or completed development/building permits, or demolitions, will still result in individual increases or decreases in assessed value. Changes in relative valuations between different properties could also have an individual impact on assessments.

- The Administrator will attend an information session on April 8th, 2025, presented by SAMA on this year's revaluation.
- MLA Brad Crassweller, (White City – Qu'appelle Constituency), attended the meeting building relationships in the area and to formally meet the Village of Edenwold Council members.
- **Website:** The Village of Edenwold website domain has experienced issues during a server process recently and is not currently accessible to users. Council is exploring next options for a viable upgrade, and met with the web design consultant to address needs and site preferences.



- The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance regarding the skating rink status and future demise. Council has also authorized an auction for some supplies, contents, and exterior material to occur spring/summer 2025. More information and notice will be given in due course.

- SK Lotteries Community Grant for 2024-2025. The Board administers the grant money annually. Final reports for this grant due March 31st, 2025. New funding should be available in a few weeks time for 2025-2026.

- Compost pickup is on a once a month winter cycle until April, 2025. New calendars for all household container pick up dates are available in the foyer of the Village Office building
