- Budget/Mill Rate 2025
Council for the Village of Edenwold will meet 7:00 p.m. in office May 22nd, 2025, to hold final budget deliberations and set the mill rate for 2025.
- Council for the Village of Edenwold received the final 2024 Financial Statement from Dudley and Company LLP audit firm. The synopsis for ratepayers' is provided in mail-out.
- Taxation Bylaw
A reminder that the 2025 Minimum Tax on 'Land Only' was set to increase to \$500 per property classification, as in the previous Bylaw 01-2024 enacted last year. Please ensure your current preferred email is sent to the Village Office as an alternative to mail strike disruption.

- Website: The Village of Edenwold website domain has experienced issues during a server process recently and is not currently accessible to users. Council has accepted the quote from the consultant for design and work for the new site.
- The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance for the Skating Rink status and future demolition.
Council has also authorized a public auction (**McDougall Auctioneers Ltd.**) to deal with the Skating Rink closure. Some rink supplies and contents, along with exterior roofing and or door materials - will occur June 19th, 2025. Viewing is slated for June 17th, 2025. All bidding will be online through McDougall Auctions and advertising provided.

ATV's PUBLIC AWARENESS

In accordance with the Village of Edenwold Traffic Bylaw 03-2013 whereby it states that all terrain vehicles and snowmobiles only use the public streets as a method of quickest possible route when leaving or entering the Village. Recreational vehicles being driven for entertainment purposes [including quads, trikes, dirt bikes, mini bikes]; there is an elevated liability risk when driving on the public streets or if unknowingly accessing privately owned property.

Recreational vehicles being driven for entertainment purposes – including quads, trikes, dirt bikes and/or mini bikes – any stunting, racing, joy riding in town is not allowed. The RCMP enforce *The Traffic Safety Act*, and it is recommended that people call these complaints in to the White Butte Detachment 306-781-5050.
