COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **July 14th, 2025**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold; please refer to www.villageofedenwold/community/bylaws/AnimalControlBylaw (Continuous barking controlled) Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries; tied in yard; fenced; dog run.

- Budget/Mill Rate 2025
Council for the Village of Edenwold held final budget deliberations and set the mill rate at 5.300 mills for 2025, at May 22nd, 2025 special council meeting. The final budget was approved at the regular council meeting held on June 9th, 2025.
- This year it is planned to continue road work this season, including gravel on 2nd Avenue and several side streets. **Canada Community-Building Fund- CCBF (formerly Gas Tax fund), will be used to pay for this project.** It includes; gravel spread on the streets, and two more moderate frost boil repairs (western end of 1st Avenue, and Eden Street).
- A drainage improvement on the south end of Eden Street; also underway should improve water flow to the existing culvert at that end of the street.
- 2025 Taxation notices have recently been sent by mail to property owners'. Tax notices due December 31st, 2025. Discounts are indicated at 5% municipal portion until July 31st, 2025, and at 3% municipal portion until September 30th, 2025.
- Website: The Village of Edenwold new website has been completed; a short training period to maintain the site is scheduled. Please watch for details when the new site is launched.
- The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance for the Skating Rink status and future demolition.
Council has also authorized a public auction (**McDougall Auctioneers Ltd.**) to deal with the Skating Rink contents. Some rink supplies and contents, along with exterior roofing and or door materials – occurring this week, with pick up dates as June 23/24, 2025. Online bidding and advertising provided.
- PAYMENTS Payment methods, debit/credit (in-office) 2.5% credit card use fee applicable; e-transfer to villageofedenwold@sasktel.net, Conexus Credit Union customers can access on-line banking (Telpay), cheques or cash. Please make payments payable to Village of Edenwold.

- Compost pickup is on summer rotation, each week on Friday. New calendars for all household container pick up dates are available in the foyer of the Village Office building.
- The Commissionaires South SK continue to monitor any issues across the Village under signed summer contract.

ATV's PUBLIC AWARENESS

In accordance with the Village of Edenwold Traffic Bylaw 03-2013 whereby it states that all terrain vehicles and snowmobiles only use the public streets as a method of quickest possible route when leaving or entering the Village. Recreational vehicles being driven for entertainment purposes [including quads, trikes, dirt bikes, mini bikes]; there is an elevated liability risk when driving on the public streets or if unknowingly accessing privately owned property. **Please do not drive any recreational vehicles out onto the soccer/field track or playground areas at the school.**

Recreational vehicles being driven for entertainment purposes – including quads, trikes, dirt bikes and/or mini bikes – any stunting, racing, joy riding in town is not allowed. The RCMP enforce *The Traffic Safety Act*.
