COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Tuesday, **October 14th, 2025**, in lieu of Thanksgiving Monday, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Council for the Village of Edenwold gave first reading to **Public Works Policy Bylaw #01-2025**. The objective is to create a policy for new and/or established guidelines and details.
- Two staff members are registered for Intermediate First Aid (CPR-C-AED-FirstAid) two day course on October 29th and 30th, 2025, in Balgonie, SK.
- The Village of Edenwold under *The Tax Enforcement Act*, has issued a Thirty (30) day notice to the property owner of Lot 1, Block B, Plan 60R02010 – to attain title to the property following a Conditional order granted through the Provincial Mediation Board.
- Wyatt Engineering Ltd, based in White City, SK, has been engaged by the Village of Edenwold to assess and provide engineering specifications for a small building to replace the existing lift station building on 3rd Avenue in Edenwold, Sk. The project scope was approved under Canada Community-Building Fund; CCBF, formerly known as *The Gas Tax Fund*. The venture is expected to bring the building portion up to standard to meet regulated requirements.
- **Big Bin solid waste day scheduled for Saturday, September 20th, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the shop/firehall compound at 105 Brewer Street, Edenwold, Sk. Residents' are encourage to read the mail out recently provided for details on fall cleanup.**
- 2025-26 Sk. Lotteries Community Grant has been approved and received. - The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance on the Skating Rink status and future demolition. The Village of Edenwold will continue to seek guidance on the demolition/clean-up protocol.

- The Commissionaires South SK continue to monitor any issues regarding bylaw enforcement across the Village, under signed summer contract.
- NO 'AT LARGE' Dogs within the Village of Edenwold; please refer to www.villageofedenwold/community/bylaws/AnimalControlBylaw (continuous barking controlled). Please walk dogs on leashes at all times within the Village boundaries; tied in yard; fenced; dog run.

ATV's PUBLIC AWARENESS

In accordance with the Village of Edenwold Traffic Bylaw 03-2013 whereby it states that all terrain vehicles and snowmobiles only use the public streets as a method of quickest possible route when leaving or entering the Village.
