## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **November 10th, 2025**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Council for the Village of Edenwold gave second and third readings to Public Works Policy Bylaw #01-2025. The objective is to create a policy for new and/or established guidelines and details.
- VILLAGE OFFICE Closed, Wednesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025, as staff members are registered for Intermediate First Aid (CPR-C-AED-FirstAid) two day course on October 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, in Balgonie, SK
- Wyatt Engineering Ltd, based in White City, SK, has been engaged by the Village of Edenwold. The firm has completed preliminary surveying and site assessment to date; for providing engineering specifications and detailed requirements for a new small building to replace the existing lift station building on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue in Edenwold, Sk. The project scope was approved under Canada Community-Building Fund; CCBF, formerly known as *The Gas Tax Fund*. The venture is expected to bring the building portion up to standard to meet regulated requirements.
- Council to consider a Violence Prevention Policy Bylaw #02-2025, and a newer Building Bylaw #03-2025, at the next regular scheduled council meeting in November, 2025.
- The Village of Edenwold is sending in another Infrastructure Investment Plan for Gov't of Sask.

  Ministerial approval (IIP 2025-26 funding through Canada Community-Building Fund; formerly known as Gas Tax Fund), for metal roofing on the Edenwold Community Hall. The upgrade will see the north roof pitch be completed with a target date of summer, 2026.
- A liquor permit request was approved by Council for the upcoming First Responder Cabaret, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, in the Edenwold Community hall.
- 2025-26 Sk. Lotteries Community Grant has been approved and received. If your group, club, committee has programming, costs, related to the delivery of the sport, culture, recreation, please contact the Village Office 306-771-4121, <a href="mailto:villageofedenwold@sasktel.net">villageofedenwold@sasktel.net</a> for more details, or submit a letter request to Edenwold Recreation Board, PO Box 130 Edenwold SK SOG 1KO.
- The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance on the Skating Rink status and future demolition. The Village of Edenwold will continue to seek guidance on the demolition/clean-up protocol.

As homeowners' are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment. The Village has set a projected date of June 1, 2026, for homeowners' to remedy the overgrowth areas. Commissionaires South SK will patrol during that time for compliance measures.
