COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **February 9th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Sk Recycles program is being considered by Municipalities across the province. The transition period over the next two years, gives more than one option for a Municipality to consider. The Village of Edenwold council considered the information over the last few weeks continuing with our current provider agreement, but opting in to the to SK Recycles program by the Feb. 1, 2028, transition deadline. Further information continues to be reviewed from all options currently available. All changes resulting from the transition to a new recycle program will be communicated to the Village residents' in due course.
- The Ministry of Government Relations confirmed the Municipal District of Prairieview - joint application with RM of Edenwold #158 and the Village of Edenwold has been withdrawn, as per the requests of both municipal councils.
- Wyatt Engineering attended the meeting as delegation to speak to Council and staff on the proposed options initial report detailing costing and project design for the lift station upgrade. The Canada Housing Infrastructure Fund (CHIF) application for the lift station project upgrades was filed on November 28th, 2025, the results of the intake are not yet known.
- Dudley & Company LLP is tentatively set for 2025 Village of Edenwold Audit on February 9th/10th, 2026.
- Trees – Shrubs – Hedges - As homeowners' are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment. **The Village has set a projected date of June 1, 2026, for homeowners' to remedy the overgrowth areas.** Commissionaires South SK will patrol during that time for compliance measures.
