COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **March 9th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Sk Recycles program-led opt-in motion from the January Council meeting for Feb. 1st, 2026, was rescinded at the Feb. 9th Council meeting. Loraas Disposal attended the meeting as a delegation and provided information on an alternate option community-led waste authority program. The program information was well received by the Council members; followed by a decision to join Red Coat Waste Resource Authority for the village's recycling needs. Loraas Disposal will remain the carrier under this Authority.
- Dudley & Company LLP audit firm had to be cancelled and re-booked; new tentative date for in office audit is March 13th, 2026.
- The 2026 Tax Enforcement List was authorized for advertising in the Quad Town Forum (Grasslands) newspaper effective January 31st, 2026. The list has been posted in the foyer of the office building.
- Trees – Shrubs – Hedges - As homeowners' are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment. **The Village has set a projected date of June 1, 2026, for homeowners' to remedy the overgrowth areas.** Commissionaires South SK will patrol during that time for compliance measures. - 2025-26 Sk. Lotteries Community Grant has been approved and received. - The Village of Edenwold has reached out to the Ministry of Environment for guidance on the Skating Rink status. Currently, the initial asbestos tests were taken January 7th, 2026, results forthcoming.
