#### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **May 11th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- The **Village of Edenwold Assessment Roll is open** for thirty days (30) for 2026, notice has been mailed separately to ratepayers; along with any change assessment notices.
- Council, by resolution, gave first reading to **Amendment Bylaw No. 01-2026 of the Taxation Bylaw 01-2024**, at the April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 regular scheduled council meeting – to raise Base tax \$150 per property with improvements, Commercial and Residential. During the upcoming 2026 budget deliberations for the Village, the mill rate will be set to align and lessen impact to the overall levy for 2026.
- Council authorized a \$200 donation to the **Greenall High School Class of 2026 Graduation Committee**. The Village of Edenwold extends sincere congratulations to the Class of 2026, and wish the best in your future endeavours.
- **Gopher trapping** is in progress over the next month at the Edenwold Sportsgrounds. \*NO pets “Off Leash” in the area while the trapping is being done. Please and thank you!
- **Spring Cleanup - BIG BIN DAY** - The large 30 yard container for Solid Waste yard cleanup will be available Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Firehall/Maintenance Shop 105 Brewer Street. Residents are encouraged to read the guidelines attached.
- **Asbestos** removal has been completed by Firmin Abatement Specialists in the former skating rink. The Village continues to work with the Ministry of Environment and is pursuing further funding for an impending demolition of the building.
- **CCBF, Canada Community-Building Fund**, has approved the Village of Edenwold upgrade to the community hall roof on the north side. Metal roofing to begin near end of May/early June. Please watch for the work crew and equipment, at that time.
- **Trees – Shrubs – Hedges** - As homeowners’ are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be



cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment. **The Village has set a projected date of June 1, 2026, for homeowners' to remedy the overgrowth areas.** Commissionaires South SK will patrol during that time for compliance measures. Thank you for understanding!
