#### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **June 8th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Council, by resolution, gave second and third readings to **Amendment Bylaw No. 01-2026 of the Taxation Bylaw 01-2024**, at the May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026 regular scheduled council meeting – to raise Base tax **\$150** per property with improvements, Commercial and Residential.
- Council, by resolution, added Karen Byrd’s appointment to the District Board of Revision (assessment appeals board), replacing a former board member.
- Council authorized the advertising for the Assessment Roll Open for 2026 in the Saskatchewan Gazette and the Quad Town Forum newspaper (Grassland News); April 17<sup>th</sup> – 2026 issues.
- Gopher trapping is in progress over the next month at the Edenwold Sportsgrounds. \*NO pets “Off Leash” in the area while the trapping is being done. Please and thank you!
- **Yard Cleanup - BIG BIN DAY** - The large 30 yard container for Solid Waste yard cleanup will be available Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Firehall/Maintenance Shop 105 Brewer Street. Residents are encouraged to read the guidelines attached.
- Council acknowledges 2026 Education Property Tax Mill Rates set by the Province of Saskatchewan, as follows: Agricultural 1.07 mills, Residential 4.27 mills, Commercial/Industrial 6.37 mils, and Resource 7.49 mills.
- Council approved 2026 Budget following deliberations; pending the 2025 Audit final reporting, and set the 2026 Uniform Mill Rate at 4.600 mills.
- **CCBF, Canada Community-Building Fund**, has approved the Village of Edenwold upgrade to the community hall roof on the north side. Metal roofing to begin near end of May/early June. Please watch for the work crew and equipment, at that time.
- **Trees – Shrubs – Hedges** - As homeowners’ are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be



cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment. **The Village has set a projected date of June 1, 2026, for homeowners' to remedy the overgrowth areas.** Commissionaires South SK will patrol during that time for compliance measures. Thank you for understanding!
