COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **Aug. 10th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, at 7:00 p.m.

- Property Tax Notices have been mailed for 2026, discounts are available on the Municipal portion to July 31st, 2026 at 5% and until September 30th, 2026 at 3%. The notices are due on December 31st, 2026. There is a 15% penalty levied January 1st for unpaid accounts at year-end.
- Council gave first reading to BYLAW 02-2026 TO AMEND BYLAW No. 02-2024 THE FIRE PREVENTION AND BURNING CONTROL BYLAW. **Section 11 to be repealed and replaced.**
- Council approved the 2025 Final Financial Statement (FS) from Dudley and Company; and authorized the Mayor and Administrator to sign the synopsis for ratepayers'.
- Council authorized an increase for insurance premium on Village owned Water Treatment Plant facilities and pumps; following a complete valuation by SunCorp in 2025. Other municipal owned property will be further addressed in the spring of 2027.
- **CCBF, Canada Community-Building Fund**, has approved the Village of Edenwold upgrade to the community hall roof on the north side. Metal roofing had been delayed until the early part of August, 2026. Please watch for the work crew and equipment, at that time.
- Annual Septic Tank pump-out information will be forthcoming in mid-August. The sign up sheets will be posted and the service is optional every year.
- **New Pilot Project**

The Village of Edenwold is announcing a tree branch, hedge trimmings drop off location: Behind the lift station at 338 – 3rd Avenue. Residents are asked to use the marked area accordingly; it has been marked off and a sign will be installed between the lift station extending several feet to the south. In the fall, the Village will have the pile mulched for residents to use as needed.



Much appreciation to homeowners who have already addressed the overgrowth bordering their own property to date. Commissionaires South SK, continue to oversee progress again this month.

[Trees – Shrubs – Hedges - As homeowners are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment.]

Within the Village boundaries, walking your dog(s) they must be on leashes at all times; within your yard they are to be in a fenced up area/dog run or tied up.
