COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The next Council meeting is on Monday, **September 14th, 2026**, at the Edenwold Community Hall, 7 p.m.

- Property Tax Notices have been mailed for 2026, discounts are available on the Municipal portion until September 30th, 2026, at 3%. The notices are due on December 31st, 2026. There is a 15% penalty levied January 1st for unpaid accounts at year-end.
- Council gave second and third readings to BYLAW 02-2026 TO AMEND BYLAW No. 02-2024 THE FIRE PREVENTION AND BURNING CONTROL BYLAW. **Section 11 has been replaced.**
- Council acknowledged the formal resignation of Councillor Paul Boehme at the meeting. The Village will take next steps in accordance with the *Local Government Election Act 2015*, to fill the vacancy at the earliest practical date. The Village of Edenwold Council and Staff wish to take this opportunity to thank Paul for nearly 14 years serving as an elected official, along with being a volunteer on the Edenwold Volunteer Fire Department (EVFD) and as an active Edenwold First Responder, for many years. Paul was also involved with the Edenwold Memorial Rink and the Edenwold Centennial Park Committee during that time as well. We wish Paul, Tracy and family the very best on their recent move and in the years ahead.
- Council appointed Councillor Sarah Lagace as Deputy Mayor at the meeting.
- The Village of Edenwold sends a big thank you to the RM of Edenwold #158, for the 2026 Recreation Grant money of \$4,000.00. Council contributed the grant money to the Edenwold Centennial Park Committee (ECPC) at the meeting.
- **2026 SEPTIC** fall pump out information for the Village of Edenwold is as follows:
Countryside Septic was selected to be the service provider this year, and the company has stated that it is imperative to be signed up on the list by September 8th, 2026. It is inconvenient for the company to have to back track for "Add-Ons" once the work has started. The 2026 rate is \$130 per residence, and those charges will be **billed out from the Village Office on the 3rd Quarter Utility billing in early October.** Thank you, this service is optional and the sign-up sheets are posted in the Village Office foyer at 128 Chamberlain Street.

- **New Pilot Project**

The Village of Edenwold is announcing a tree branch, hedge trimmings drop off location: Behind the lift station at 338 – 3rd Avenue. Residents are asked to use the marked area accordingly. In the fall, the Village will have the pile mulched for residents to use as needed. **Much appreciation to homeowners who have already addressed the overgrowth bordering their own property to date.** Commissionaires South SK, continue to oversee progress again this month.

[Trees – Shrubs – Hedges - As homeowners are responsible for overgrowth of trees, shrubs, and hedges from their property line, the Village of Edenwold is asking each property owner to check in back yard, or side yard – over fences. The easements (alleyways), need to be cleared for first responding vehicles, utility trucks, Village maintenance equipment.]

Within the Village boundaries, when walking your dog(s); it must be on a leash; and within your yard, to be in a fenced area/dog run or tied up. **New Tags are available for annual dog licence renewals. Contact the Village office to renew your dog licence.**
